

South Africa Citizens

Copy of passport for both the bride and the groom. If you have your own witnesses, a copy of their passport is also required

You have to be 18 years and older to get married

Marriage license

Copy of full birth Certificates of bride and groom

Both parties are obliged to provide a full birth certificate. Shorter versions will not be accepted.

Divorce certificate if any

If either party has been divorced, please provide a certified copy of the Decree Absolute.

Adoption certificates if any

APOSTILLE STAMP

This stamp refers the legalization and validity of your documents for international use. (1961 Hague Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents). The Apostille Stamp is necessary for Birth certificates, Certificates of no Impediment to marry, Official documents about changing your name and Adoption certificates.

All the above documents, need to be translate via the Greek Embassy of your area. No other source is acceptable

You have to be in Greece 1 (one) business day after your wedding to register your wedding. If that is not possible, you must obtain a document that will give Marryposa Royal Events the authority to register your wedding on your behalf and you have to contact us to send you via email a sample of that authorization.
